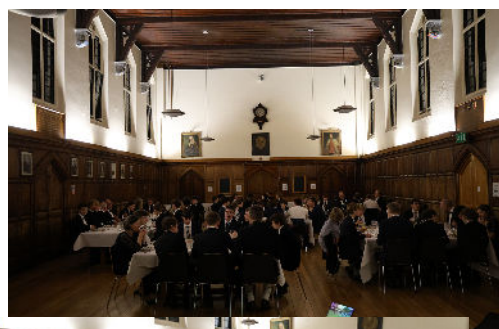

Registration-

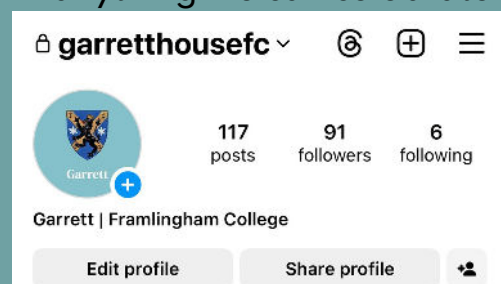
